1 What is ACDSee Quick View?

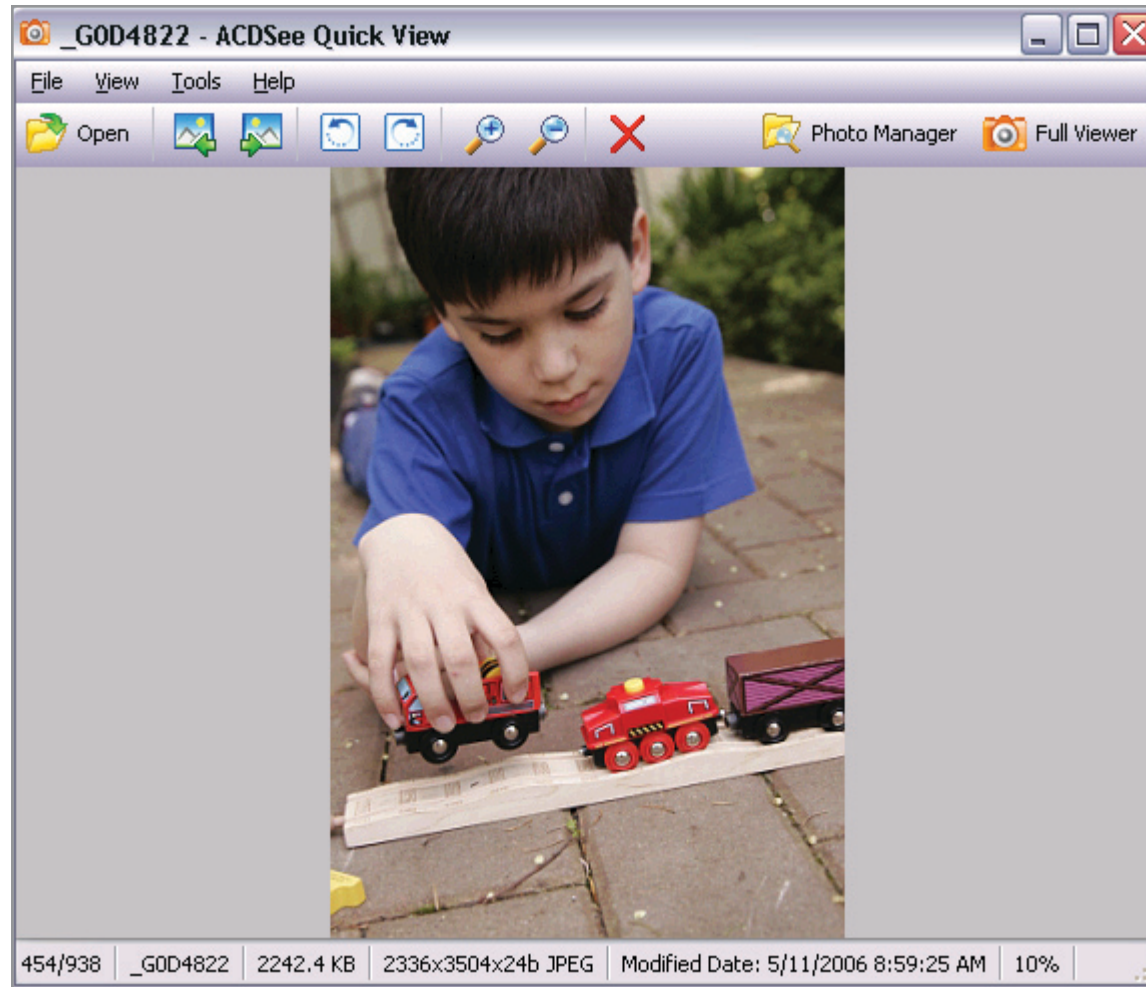

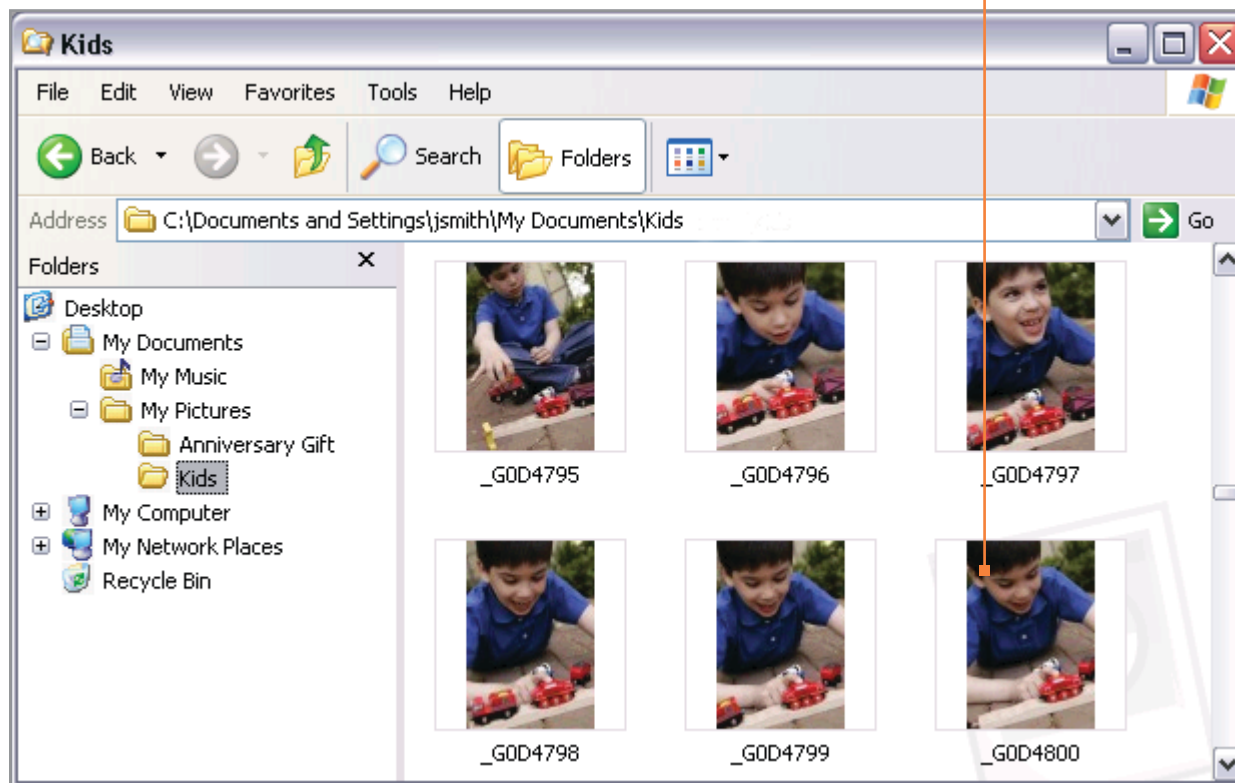

Opening photos in Quick View is incredibly easy. Just double-click a photo attached to an e-mail or stored on your computer. The photo opens in Quick View.

The Quick View toolbar includes only essential viewing options. Quickly flip through photos using the **Previous** and **Next** buttons. Rotate photos using the **Rotate Left** and **Rotate Right** buttons. Use the zoom buttons to get a closer look at your photos. Open photos in the **Photo Manager** browser or **Full Viewer**.



The Quick View status bar shows valuable information about your photo.

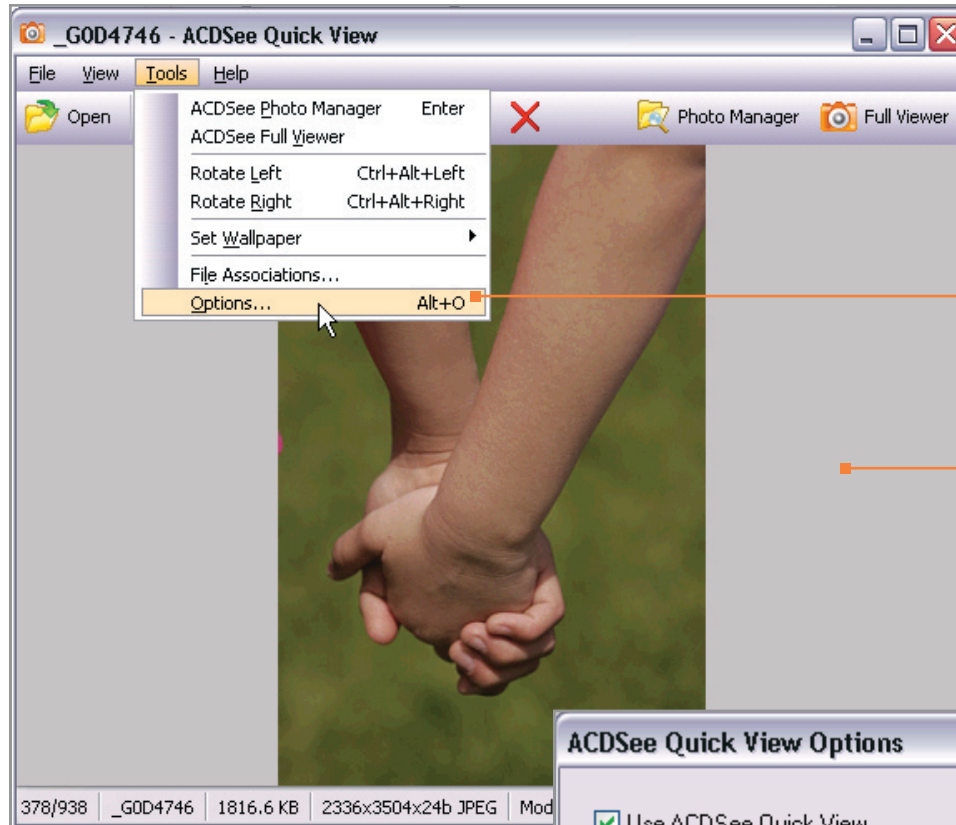

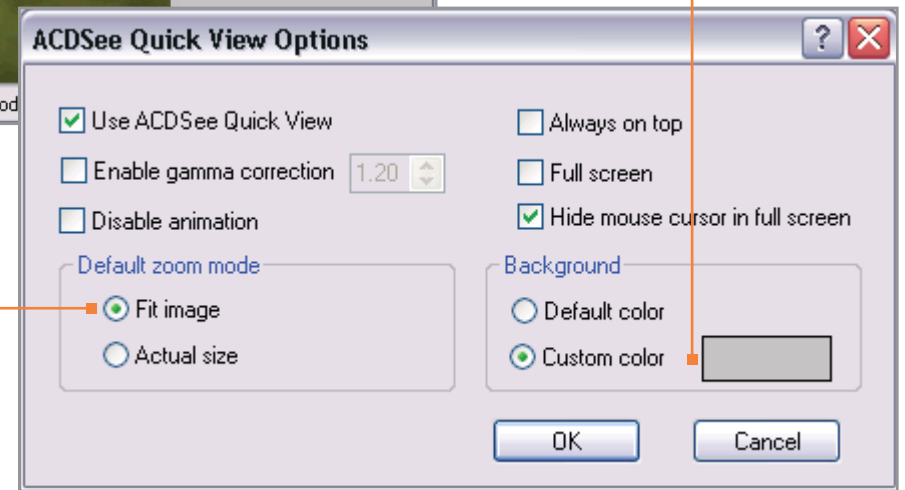

Click **Tools | Options** to display the ACDSee Quick View Options dialog.

Select **Default color** to use the background color of the ACDSee browser in Quick View, or select **Custom color** and click the color panel to choose another color.

If you want photos to fit into the Quick View window, select **Fit image**. If you want photos to display at their actual size, select **Actual size**.

- » You can customize the background color of the Quick View window, as well as the size at which photos display in Quick View.
