The number of photos displays in the year, month, or day header.

The months, days, and hours that photos are available are bolded.

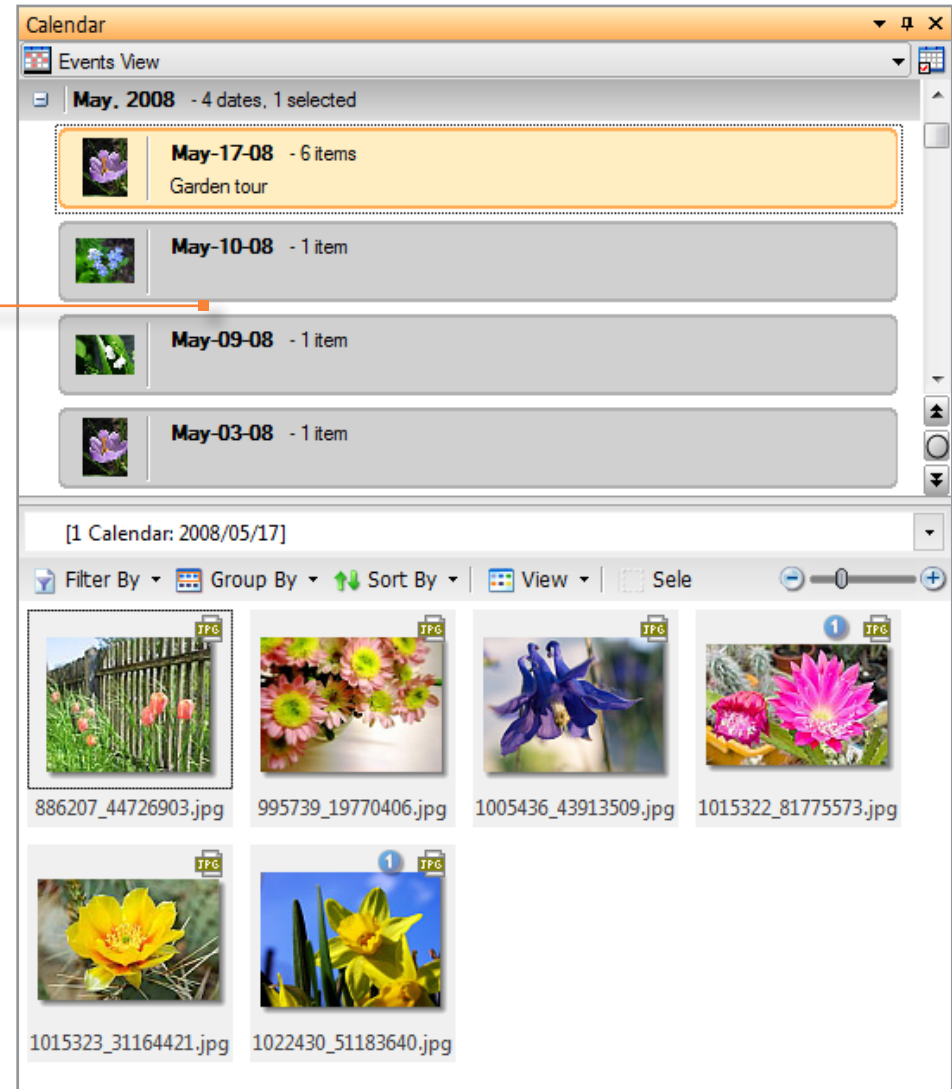

In ACDSee you can also browse your photos by event.

Events are listed under the month in which they occur. Only those dates for which photos are available display in the Events View.

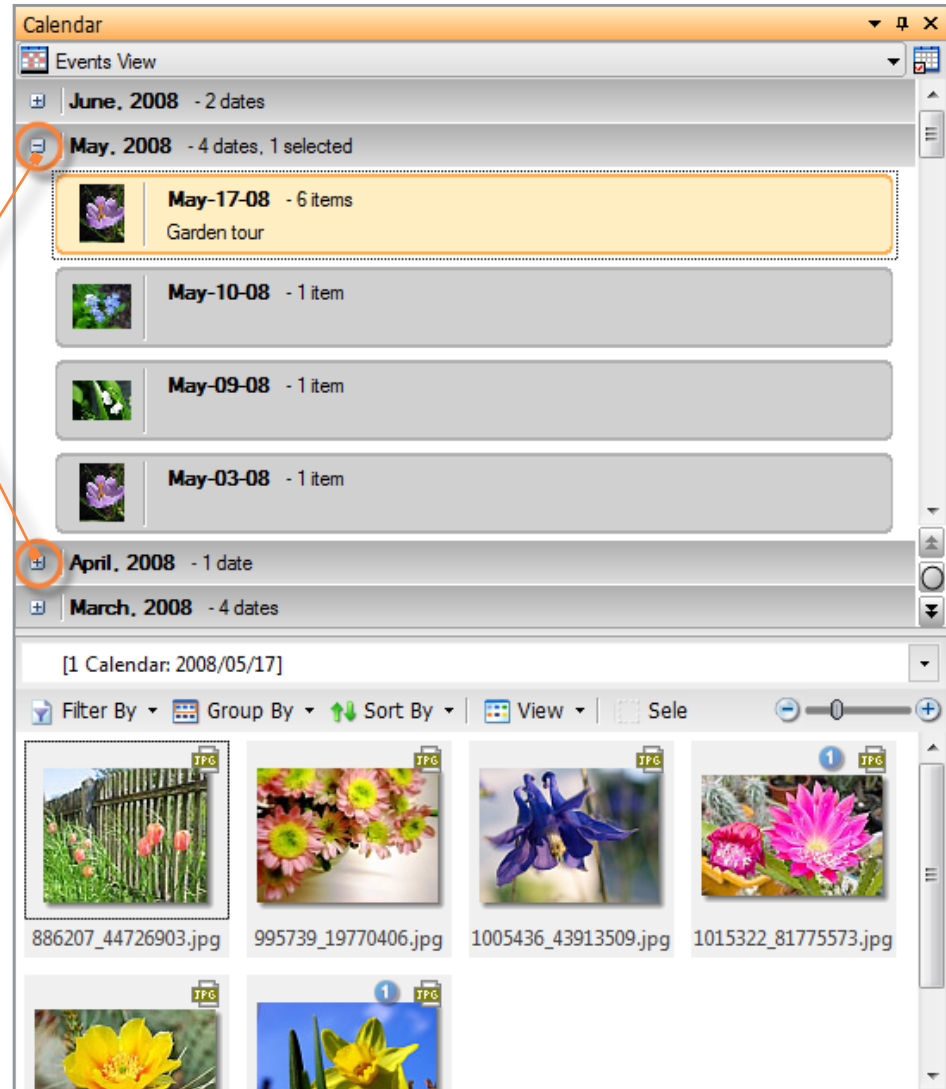

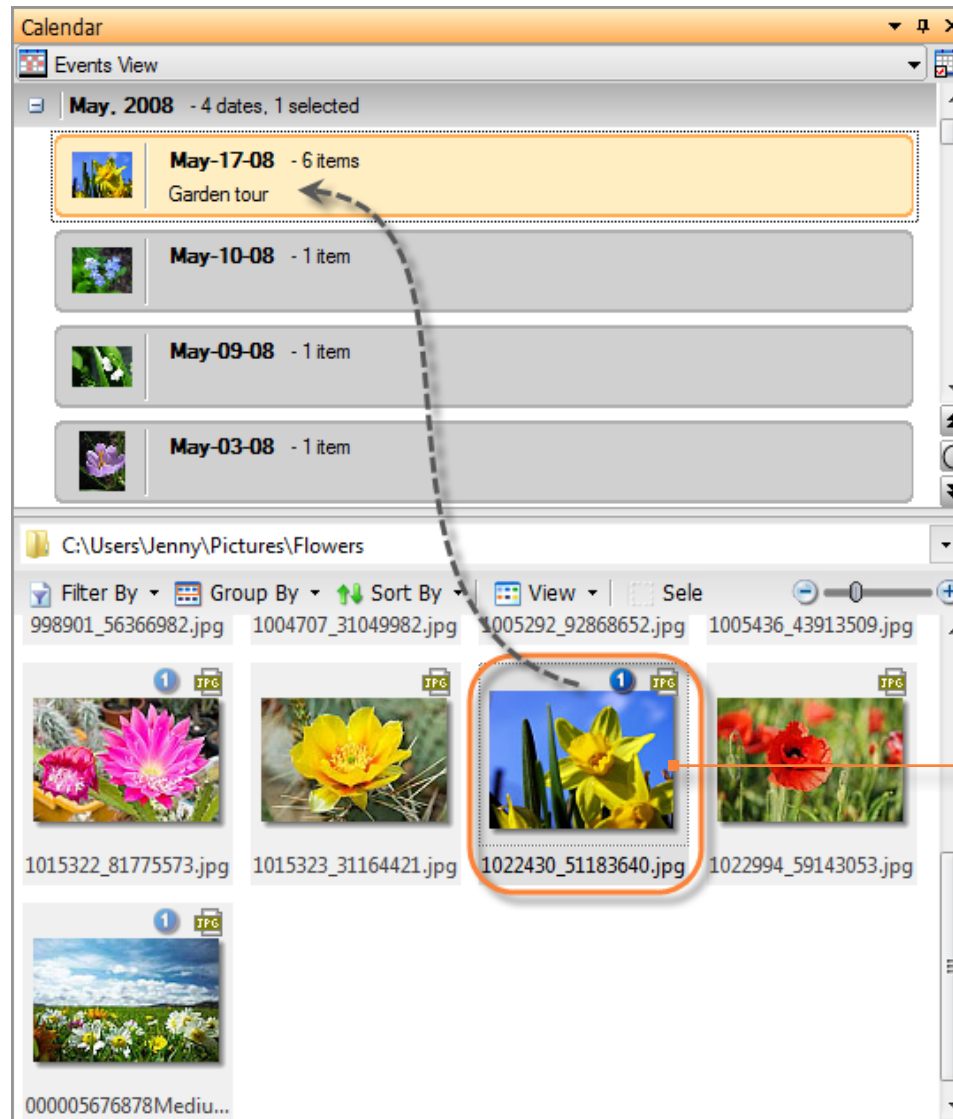

### Check to see if you learned these key concepts:

- » You can browse your photos by year, month, day, or event.
- » The number of photos displays in the year, month, day, or event header.
- » In the year, month, and day views you can identify the month, day, and hour that photos are available because they are bolded.
- » In the event view only those days on which photos are available are displayed.
- » You can personalize the event view by selecting a photo to help you remember the event and by adding an event description.
